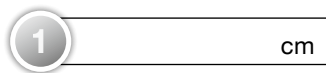
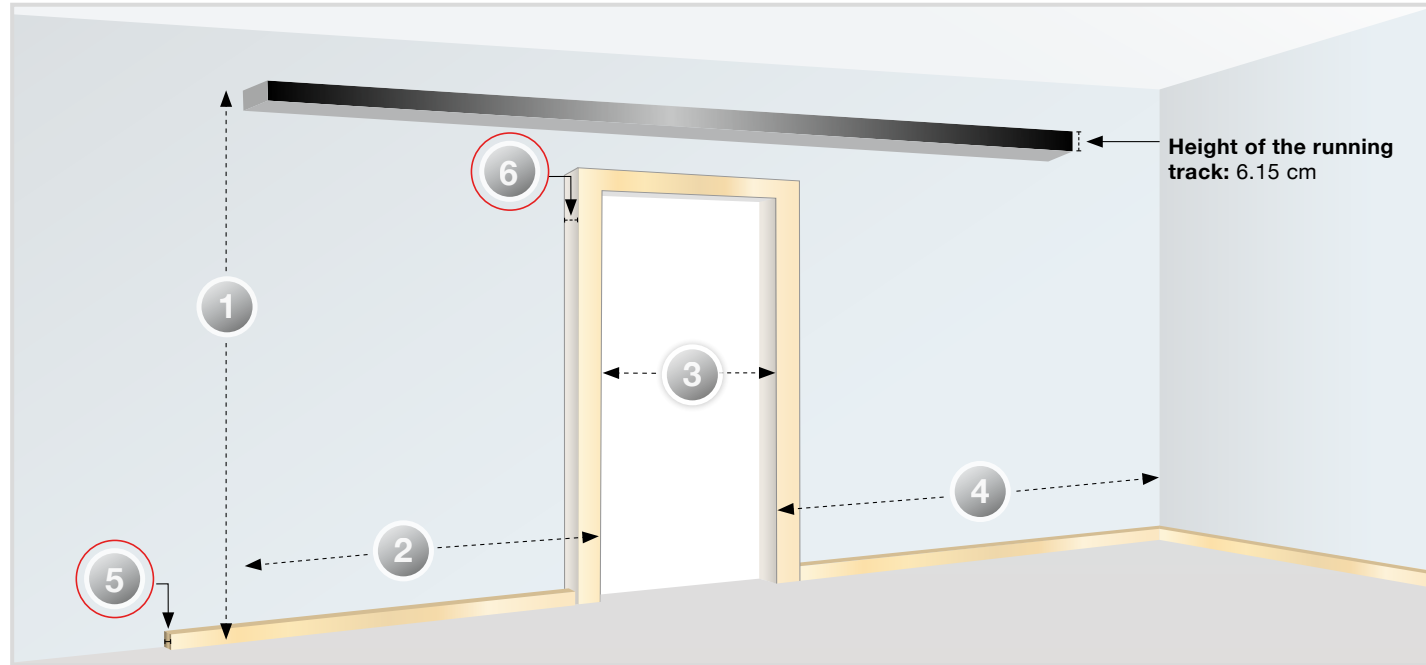
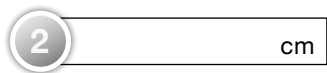


Measurement instruction: pass-through door/wall installation

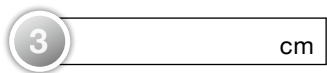
Required tools: tape measure, adhesive tape, and the printed measurement guide



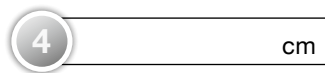
1 cm
Height from the top edge of the running track to the floor



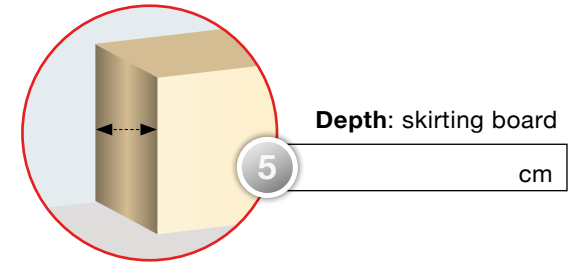
2 cm
Width of the left wall (always measure at the inside edge of the door frame)



3 cm
Width of the door opening + 4 cm (measure from inside edge to inside edge of the door frame)

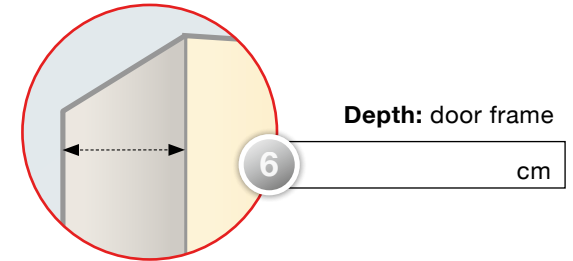


4 cm
Width of the right wall (always measure at the inside edge of the door frame)

Step A:

First, apply a strip of adhesive tape to the wall where your upper track will be installed later. Just make sure it is not too close to your door frame (at least 10 cm above). Now, you can easily measure the dimensions ①, ②, ③, ④.

Step B:

For wall installation, it is important to know how far the upper track should be from the wall. After all, your sliding door should not hit the skirting boards or door frame (if present). We will then send you a suitable spacer profile.

Therefore, we need the depth of the skirting board (⑤) and the door frame (⑥).

Step C:

After measuring, you can simply enter the dimensions into the sliding door configurator at <https://www.furnfab.com/en/products-sliding-doors>.

Note on the running tracks:

We make the width of the tracks (top and bottom) exactly twice as wide as your opening, so that you can slide the door(s) completely to the side and fully open the passage.
